As the Church Grows

Paul oversaw much of the growth of the early church, including the growth of a group of men who would be called pastors. Recognizing a need for leadership, he clarified this New Testament office in what the Holy Spirit gave him to write in his letters.

Read Titus 1:5-9

Qualifications

Paul's letters give us a picture of ministry, often as a frame that shows us what the qualifications of a pastor are more than showing us the day to day operations of a pastor.

Read 1 Timothy 3:1-7

Shepherd of the Flock

Peter was a great leader of the early church. As he writes to pastors, we get another sense of what a pastor is (and the use of the word for "pastor": shepherd).

Read 1 Peter 5:1-5

Preach

Throughout the New Testament, we see that pastors are to proclaim the Word of God to people.

Read 2 Timothy 4:1-5



Ministry Models

Paul talks about ministry with the Ephesian elders (fellow pastors raised up by Paul).

Read Acts 20:28-35
